<p>Muster Spanish merinos</p> <p>Make comparisons between these and modern Australian merinos</p> <p>View Belgenny buildings:</p> <p>The “death” tour – buildings/structures related to deaths at Belgenny over time (cottage, creamery, bell, mill). Discuss changes in local farming over time indicated by these structures.</p> <p>Observe and explain operation of No 2 Dairy.</p> <p>Nepean River – observation and Streamwatch “bug” survey to determine quality of the river.
